The Indo German student exchange programme continued in 2018 with the visit of six German language students of classes IX to XII from DPS, GBN to Germany in from May 16-June 02, 2018. The Indian students were welcomed by the host families and they spent time in observing and adapting to the lifestyle of German families and tried to build the foundation of lifelong relationships. Students went to the school THG, Ludqigshafen where they were welcomed in a special assembly.



Students went to Hack Museum in Ludwighshafen, German Parliament (Reichstag) in Berlin, Brandenburg Gate in Berlin, Reichstag Building, Holocaust Memorial and Museum. They all enjoyed their visit to the Fernsehmuseum (Film and Television Museum) in Berlin, Brandenburger Gate and were mesmerised with the views from the Ship Tour. Later, they went to BASF (Baden Aniline and Soda Factory) and learned about the contribution of chemistry to our world. Then it was time for a weekend trip to France with the host Families and Ms.Maja Bard, educator associated with THG, Ludswighafen. In France students explored the cathedral Notre –Dame and shopped many souvenirs. Towards the end, students visited Speyer and walked down to Imperial Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption and St Stephen. They specially loved the visit to Hambacher Castle, Heidelberg. On the last day of school, Indian students dressed in traditional Indian attire presented a bouquet of songs and dance for the host school and shared their experiences in Germany and also encouraged the students to continue this exchange program in the future. .
