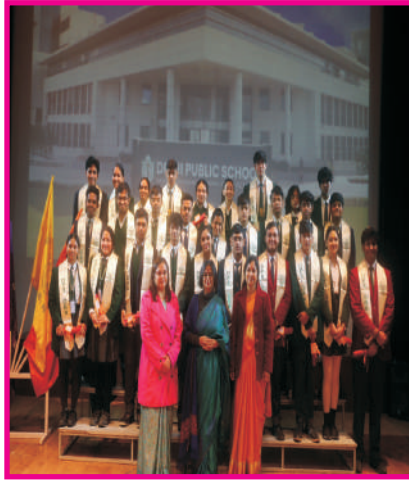

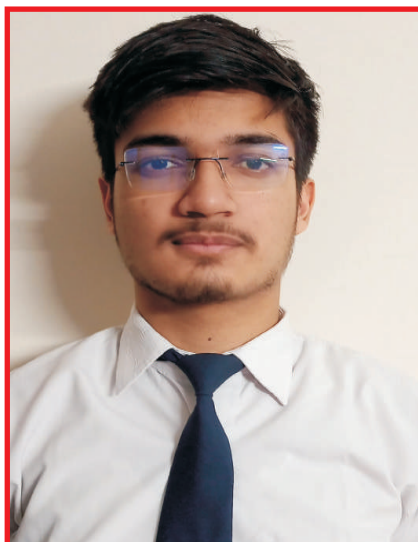
## ACHIEVEMENTS

## CITATION CEREMONY

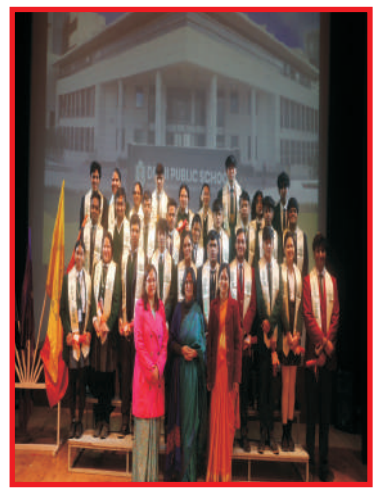
### "Blossoming Futures: The Citation Ceremony of Grade 12 at DPS, GBN"

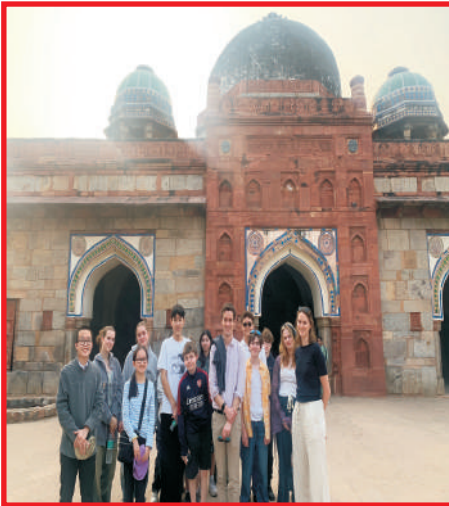

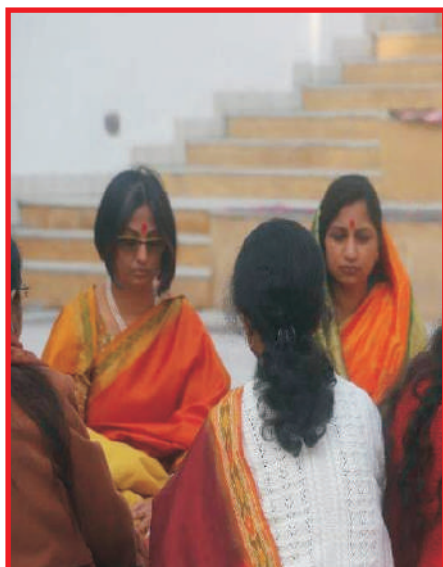


## BLESSING CEREMONY FOR GRADE 10
