A Wrap-Up of Our Creative Competition!

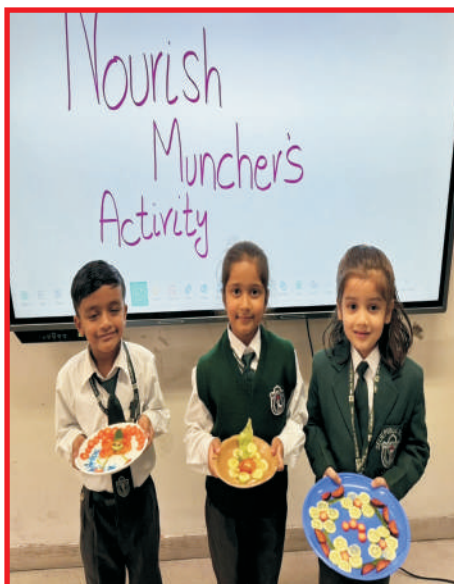
