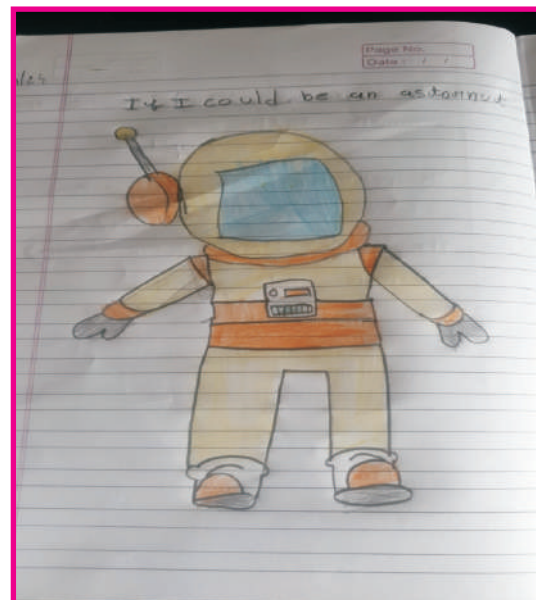
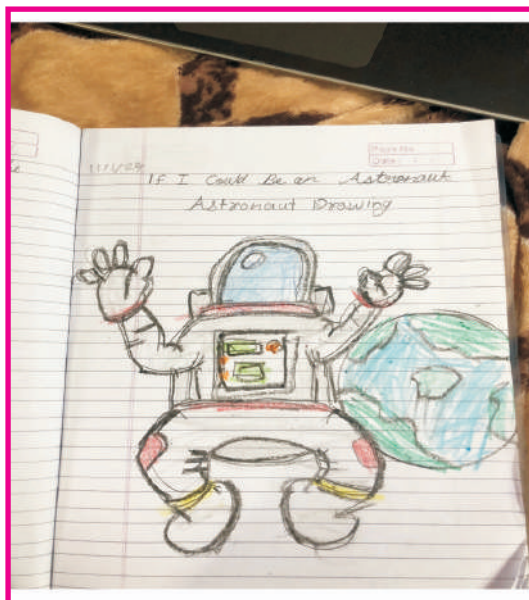


## Subject Integrated Activities

***"The only way to learn Mathematics is to do Mathematics."*— Paul Halmos**

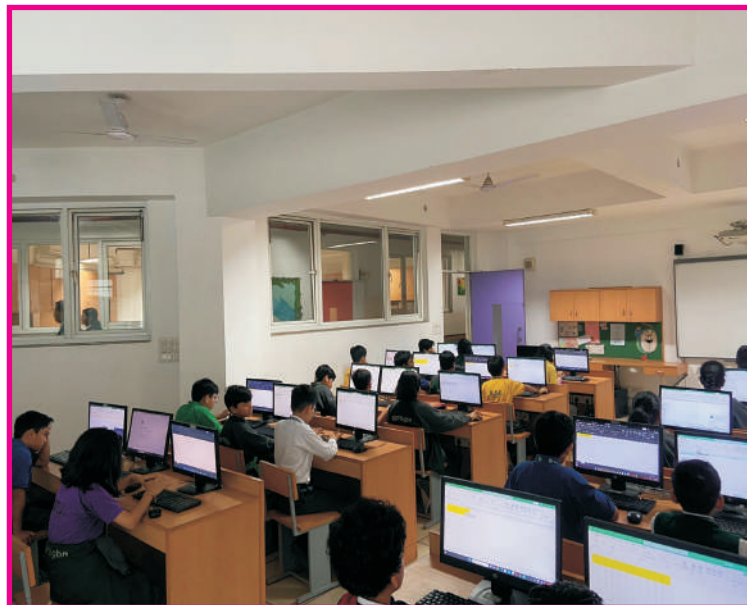

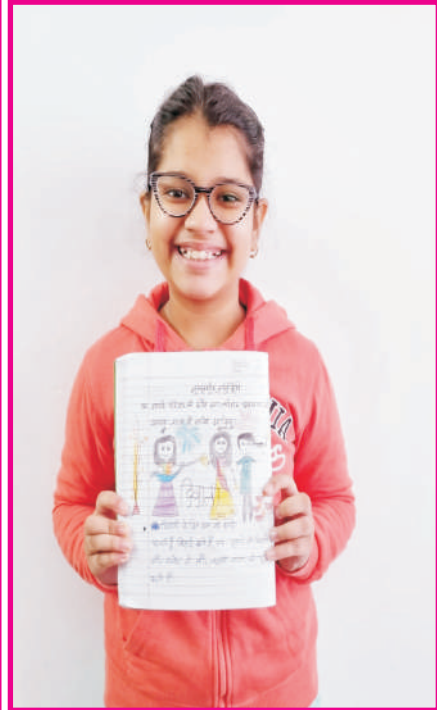
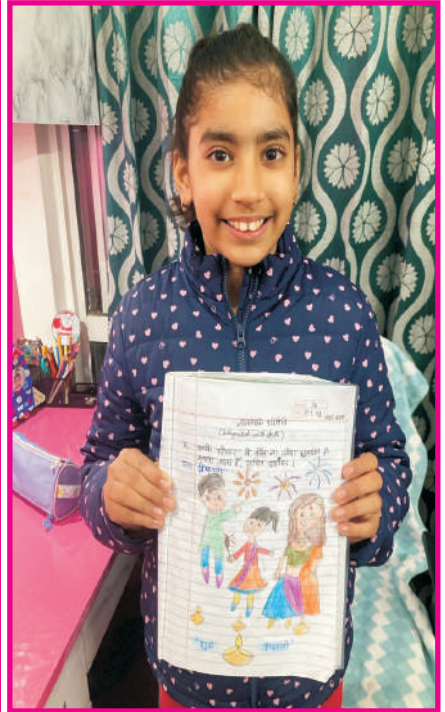
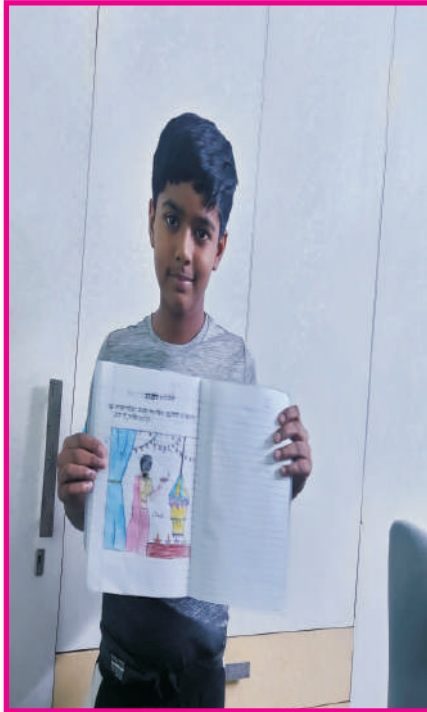
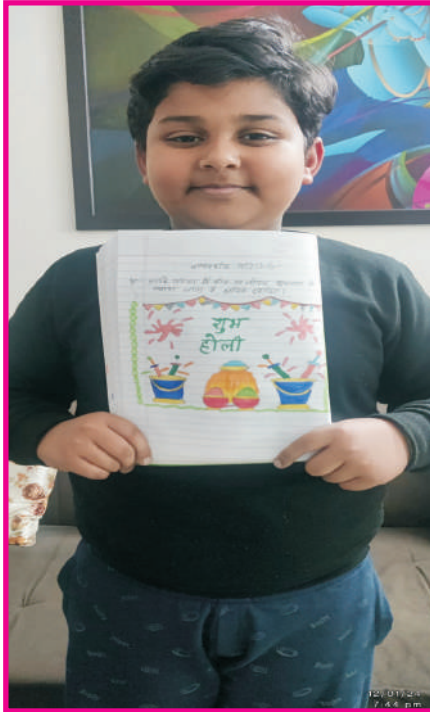


## त्योहारों का मज़ा परिवार के साथ

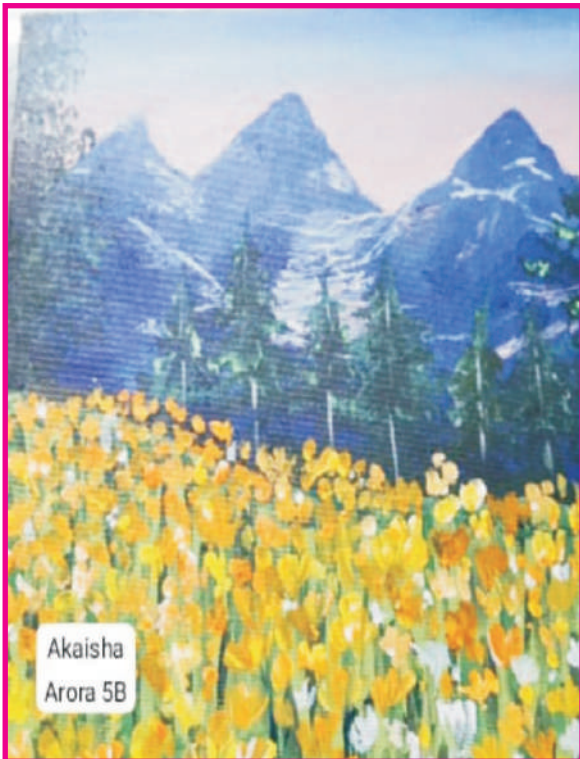
