### Computer

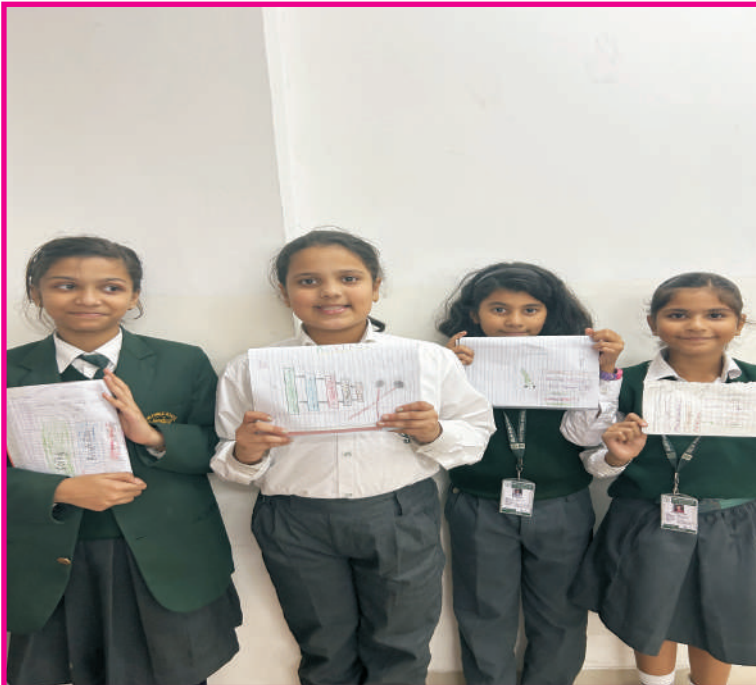
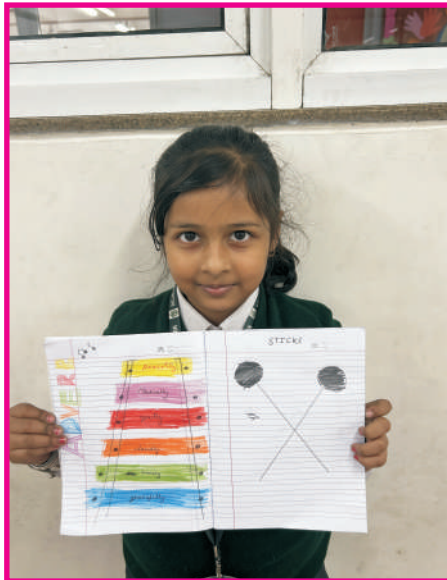
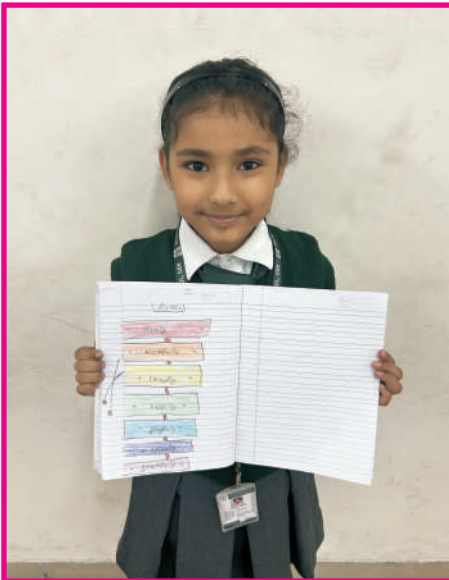

## English

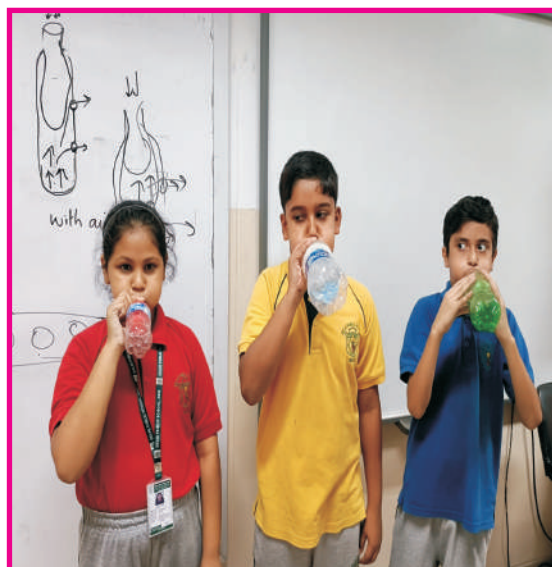
