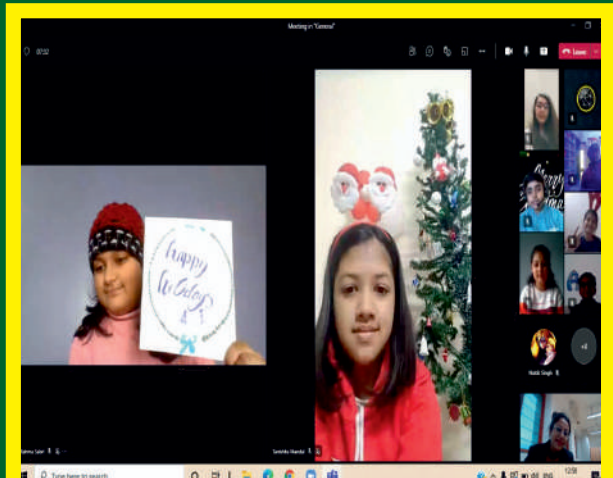
Christmas Celebration

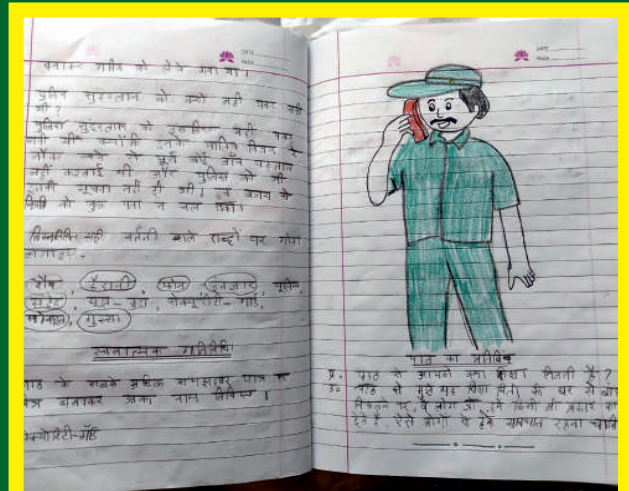
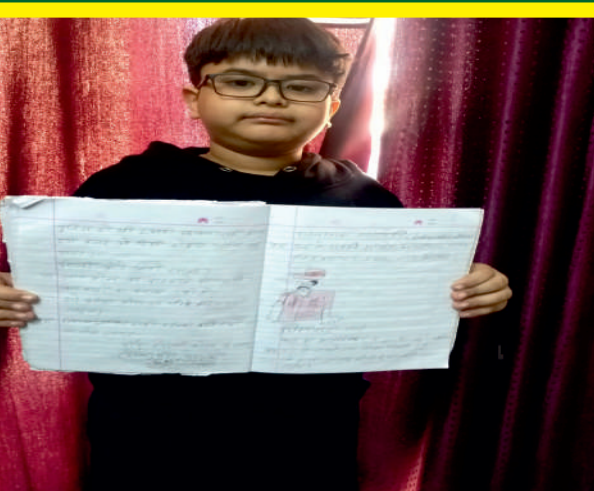
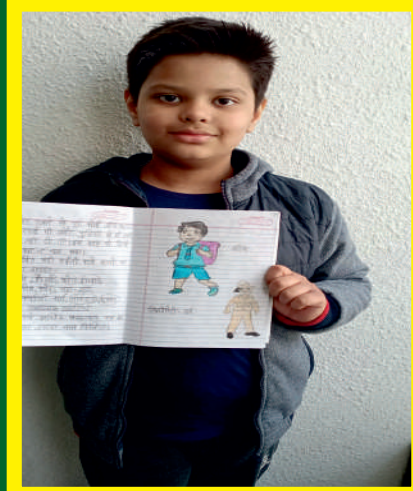
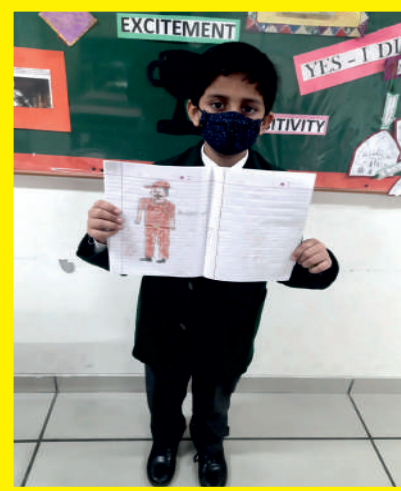
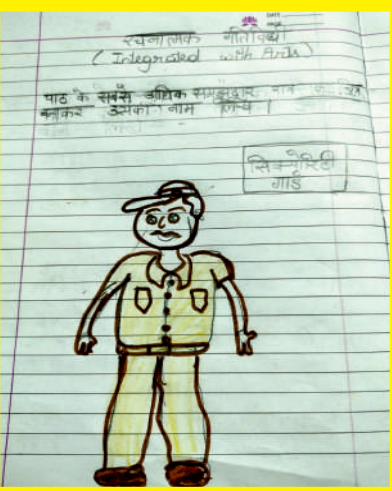


Hindi Activity Report

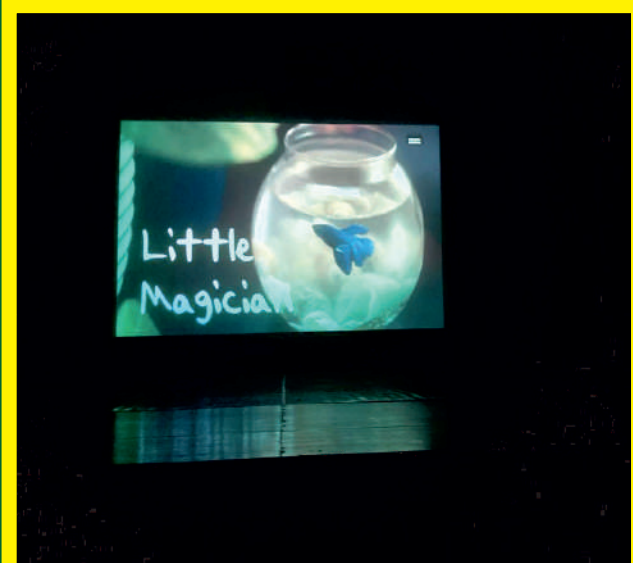

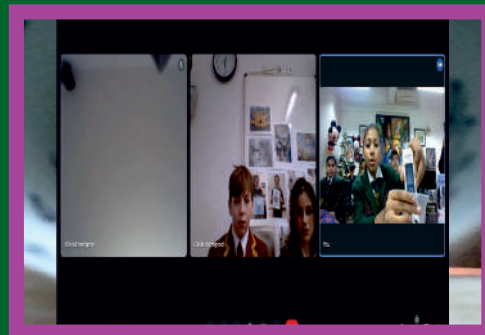
Collaborative Activity

Collaboration with Jamia Islamia School, Malawi

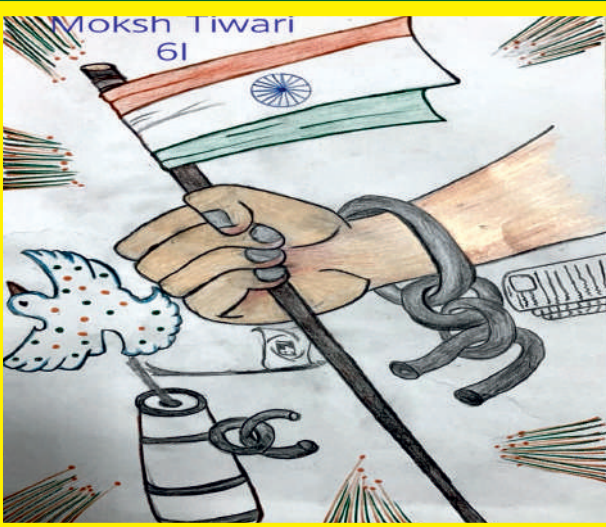
Intending to widen its horizons, DPS, GBN collaborated with, Jamia Islamia School, Malawi on the theme, 'Save Water'.
