To commemorate this beginning, a number of special activities were conducted by the teachers. The intention of these introduction activities was to let the students express themselves and get to know each other.

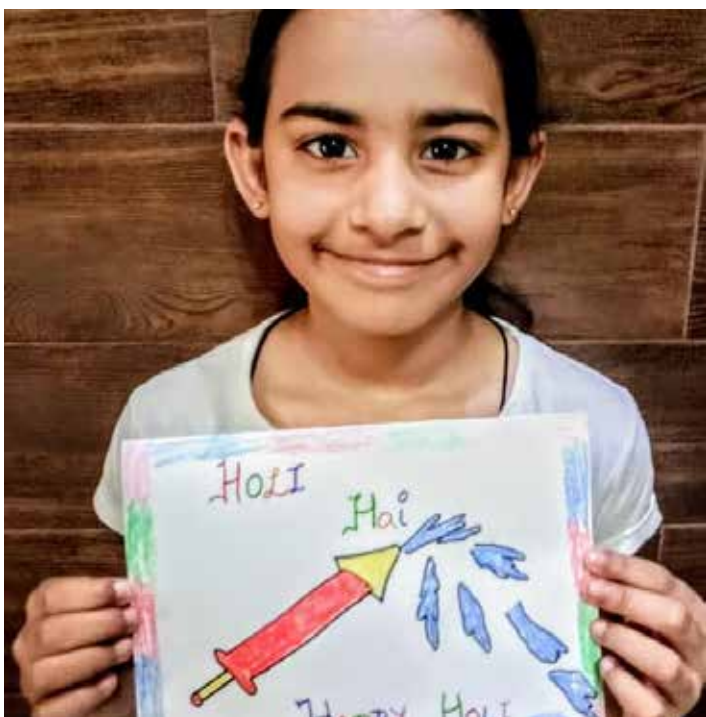
The first day of the session 2021-22 was truly a success because of a great deal of effort and endurance put together by the staff of DPS, GBN.
