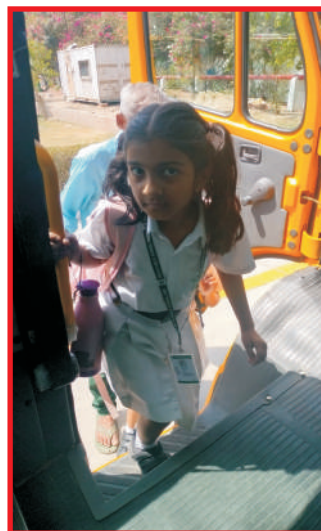
Transformational Teacher's Award 2025

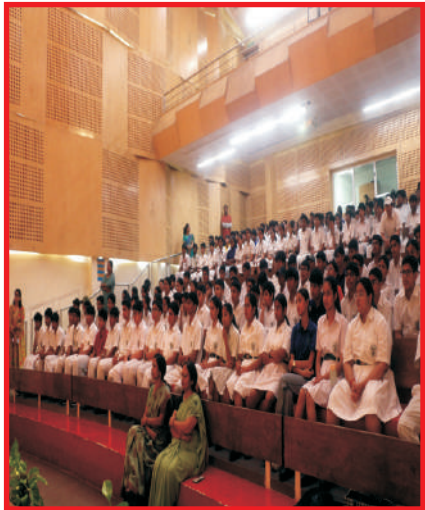
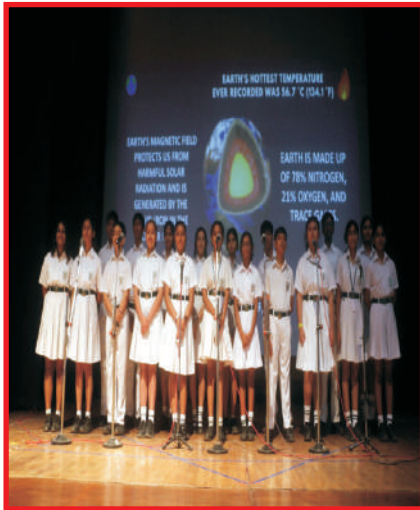

Author's Meet; Book Week Celebration

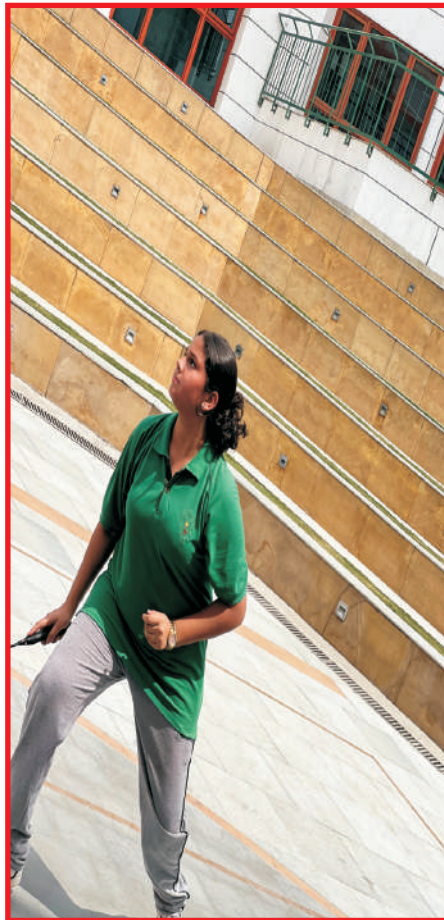
